A TIME FOR ACTION

I have written about the quantity and quality of communist literature which reaches the Spanish-speaking students of the Western Hemisphere and have urged that literature which exposes the false doctrines, hideous history, deceitful strategies and evil intentions of communism be prepared in their Spanish language and distributed to them. We are now doing just that, and I plead for your active participation and sacrificial help.

I enclose a copy of the English edition of the booklet, "Why I Am Against Communism." Please read it and refresh your own understanding of just how deadly communism has been in the past and intends to be in the future. The message is clear, and easily understood, and it provides incontrovertible evidence of the hideous record the communists have written by their deeds, and the equally hideous actions that are demanded by their doctrines if, and when, their designs for world conquest are complete. We will distribute this English edition widely to the high school and college students in the U.S.A. and to the general public.

We have prepared and printed a Spanish translation of this message and propose to distribute one million copies of this Spanish edition, "Por Que Estoy En Contra del Comunismo," to the Spanish-speaking students of the U.S.A., Mexico, Central America, South America, and the Caribbean. The communists will find it difficult to deceive, ensnare and recruit any student who has read this message.

The booklet will be distributed in many ways. Some will receive it through the mails; some will read it in their school libraries; and some will have it handed to them by individuals. The printing, mailing and general distribution of this message will cost money.

We hope to be able to print and distribute these booklets at a cost of approximately 25 cents per copy. The distribution of one million copies will cost \$250,000. This is a large sum for us, but surely it is not beyond the capacity of concerned and compassionate anti-communists to raise this amount. The biggest danger is that many will approve and even applaud this project but will assume that others will contribute and carry it out. My prayerful plea is that each person who reads this letter will ask and answer the question, "How much can I send?"

The fulfillment of our plan to distribute one million copies will require sacrifice. Some must give substantial amounts. Is it too much to hope that we will receive at least two gifts of \$10,000 and five gifts of \$5,000? We will then be on our way to victory. It is easy to draw up a table of how the \$250,000 required could be supplied, and I will do so as it is good to have a clear goal: [table not shown]

Some may prefer to give securities, real estate, or other property. There may be tax advantages by giving this way. Gifts to the Crusade are fully tax-deductible, and there is an extra tax advantage if the stock or property has experienced a capital gain.

You may not be in a position to give all you would like to give at this present time. Could you indicate your intention to give a stated amount during the next 12 months? Your assurance of coming support would help us greatly as we develop our program.

If you are unable to make a substantial personal gift, you may be able to persuade others to invest. Can you present this project to a foundation, a business firm, or an individual of your acquaintance who is able to donate? We will cooperate fully by providing any information or material you request for such a purpose.

Can you think of any better investment? The communist program for expansion and conquest requires the recruitment of young students into the ranks of the opponents of the U.S.A. and the supporters of communism. The success of this

program is evident in El Salvador, Guatemala, the Philippines, and many other countries where communist-led guerrilla war is raging.

The process of recruitment usually follows a pattern. The student becomes a communist by successive stages: 1) Anti-imperialist; 2) Anti-capitalist; 3) Pro-socialist; 4) Pro-communist; and 5) Communist. Many then take the final step of enlisting in communist-organized and communist-led armies.

This process is directed by trained communist agents who present the potential recruit with literature which gives a false but persuasive message that the U.S.A. is imperialistic and enslaving while communism is liberating and compassionate.

By giving these potential recruits literature which tells the truth about the doctrines, history, organizations, methods and objectives of communism, their recruitment can be halted and the communist offensive stalled. To wait till the guerrilla armies are fighting in the fields and cities is to wait too long.

A contribution to help distribute one million copies of "Por Estoy En Contra del Comunismo" to the Spanish-speaking students of this hemisphere is truly a contribution to peace and freedom. Please complete the questionnaire on the enclosed envelope and return it to me with your best gift.
