"Dear Dr. Schwarz,

"Having finished reading your work, *Beating the Unbeatable Foe: One Man's Victory Over Communism, Leviathan, and the Last Enemy*, I can now write you this letter. It was very instructive to relive these crucial years of our history, but also a reminder that history is repetitive and no doubt unending. The fight against Communism is not over yet, as you make abundantly clear every month in your newsletter. Nonetheless, it is gratifying that a great mass of evil in the world has been dealt a major blow, forcing our enemies to new stratagems with the loss of their major power base in Russia.

"And Leviathan remains a problem, even though free men and women have voted against it more often than not in recent years. You correctly understood long ago that a people who abandons moral virtue (especially intellectuals),

more than a people in poverty, is easy prey for despotism of any sort. Herbert Marcuse's attempts to corrupt human sexuality are the best evidence that the drive for Communism is simultaneously a war against human dignity.

"Aside from any observations that reading your book may have helped me to make, my main reason for writing this letter is to acknowledge that I am one of those thousands—perhaps millions—of Americans, who were educated by your literature and your lectures. I spent a week at the Oakland School of Anti-Communism in early 1962. Through your book, *You Can Trust the Communists* (to do Exactly as They Say) and your other literature and your lectures, your message came through loud and clear: the Communists are dedicated to a utopian ideal which they will move heaven and earth to achieve, sacrificing everything and everyone, and abandoning both intellectual honesty and moral principle, in the process. The most insidious thing about the doctrine is its redefinition of economics, politics, morality, religion and philosophy in order to facilitate the achievement of the ultimate objective. And of course the only regime compatible with the goal of unrestrained liberty and equality is a totalitarian dictatorship in which the rulers claim to be infallible, and human reason and human virtue are forbidden to flower.

"The fundamental insight into communist doctrines which you taught to me and to so many others was vital to my subsequent liberal education in political science and philosophy. There are a thousand snares awaiting the unwary who confuse their first glimmerings of understanding with intellectual superiority. And since the passion for power and dominion over others is always present to one degree or another in all of us, a doctrine which promises a utopia which only the members of an intellectual elite have the capacity to bring about, is exceedingly attractive. Since the acceptance of communism requires the rejection of common sense, love of one's family and friends, devotion to one's fellow citizens, sincere religious devotion and openness to the truth, its adherents indulge the delusion of having power to contradict and ultimately to destroy 'everything existing.' You helped me to escape that delusion. Thus, you were not surprised when the collapse of the Soviet Empire did not cause leftist western intellectuals to abandon their devotion to Marxism. . .

"One of the most compelling parts of your book is your account of the attempts of leading liberals in the early 1960s to characterize as 'extremist' your efforts to educate the public to the full dimension of the communist threat to the world. I have a powerful feeling of 'deja vu' from the fact that today's liberals are no less determined to smear the opposition. Perhaps I should say that you reminded me of just how determined liberals were in those days to crush their critics and that it didn't start with PC or with the current Democratic administration! Unfortunately, the liberal libel on the Christian Anti-Communism Crusade was effective, and it dispirited most of the anti-Communist movement in those days—precisely what it was designed to do. There are few things people fear more than being unfashionable or socially unacceptable, and the extremist label was effectively employed to teach a sneering contempt for those foolish enough to resist the moral and intellectual superiority of what Jaffa called (in one of Spiro Agnew's speeches) 'the effete corps of impudent snobs.' You were unbowed and undaunted during this withering assault, primarily because of your deep religious faith and your extraordinary grasp of the intellectual delusions of communism. The nation and the world owe you a debt of gratitude which, like all such debts, cannot and will not ever be repaid. But let this letter serve as one man's payment on that debt, first assumed when I was a young college student and now being paid in very small part in my 27th year of college teaching.

God bless you for your inestimable contribution to human freedom!"

"More than 130 people from 55 countries met here for the Second International Coordinating Committee (ICC) meeting for the 14th World Festival of Youth and Students. The February 19-22 meeting heard reports from preparatory committees across the globe and decided the program and schedule for the festival.

"The youth festival, which will be held in Cuba July 28-August 5, is shaping up to be a gathering of several thousand people who will discuss and debate a range of political questions confronting the working class, including anti-imperialist struggles, the environment, the fight for women's liberation, national liberation struggles, employment, education, labor resistance, and how to fight against fascism.

"Preparatory committees have formed in over 40 countries so far. Cuban youth leaders have toured roughly 30 countries and are slated to travel elsewhere in the coming months in preparation for the festival. In France organizers are setting up concerts to raise money for delegates to go. Groups from the Middle East and Africa plan to send people from several countries by boat to increase participation and cut down on costs.

"Some half dozen different organizations from Chile sent representatives to the ICC meeting."

China defeats the US in the United Nations

The May 5-11 edition of the Chinese Communist Magazine, *Beijing Review*, reports:

"An anti-China move by a group of Western countries, led by the United States, was defeated on April 15 at the 53rd session of the United Nations Commission on Human Rights. . .

"The new anti-China draft was put forward at the last minute. On the one hand, the carefully-worded draft resolution had to recognize China's progress in its economic development, improvements in its legal system and protection of human rights. But it criticized China's legal system, religious policy, and policy on Tibet." (Page 5)

In response, China moved a motion of "no action." It was carried by 27-17 with nine abstentions.

Beijing Review claims:

"Diplomatic sources in Geneva said the victory not only belonged to China, but to all the countries that pursue a policy of promoting and protecting human rights through international cooperation and dialogue."

JOINT STATEMENT BY THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA AND THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION ON THE MULTIPOLARIZATION OF THE WORLD AND THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A NEW INTERNATIONAL ORDER

(The May 12-18 edition of the Chinese Communist Magazine, *Beijing Review*, published a joint statement by China and Russia on the New International Order) Here are extracts:

"The two sides shall, in the spirit of partnership, strive to promote the multipolarization of the world and the establishment of a New International Order.

"Both sides maintain that mutual respect for sovereignty and territorial integrity, mutual non-aggression, non-interference in each other's internal affairs, equality and mutual benefit, peaceful coexistence and other universally recognized principles of international law should serve as the basic norms governing state-to-state relations and the basis for the establishment of a New International

Order. . .

"No country should seek hegemony, practice power politics or monopolize international affairs. . .
(Is this a criticism of the USA?)

The United Nations

"Both sides are of the view that the role of the UN and its Security Council should be strengthened, and that UN efforts in maintaining world peace and security merit a positive appraisal. Believing that the UN, as the most representative and authoritative organization composed of sovereign states, has a world capacity that no other international organization can possibly replace, both sides are convinced that it ought to be allowed to play an important role in the establishment and maintenance of a New International Order. . .

History

"The vast number of developing countries and the Non-Aligned Movement are important forces in promoting world multipolarization and building a New International Order. . . Their rise will give a strong boost to the historical process toward the establishment of a New International Order. . .

The Imminent Future

"With a new era quickly approaching, under what kind of an international order will people live in the next century? This question has been put before the people of all countries in all its seriousness. The two countries call on all other countries in the world to engage in active dialogue on the establishment of a just and equitable New International Order based on peace and stability and stand ready to discuss together the constructive proposals to this end." One man's victory over communism

Book review of Dr Fred Schwarz's Beating the Unbeatable Foe

The foremost crusader against communism in American, Frederick C Schwarz, M.D., has finally put into print the story of his life and his crusade against communism. Since his young manhood in Australia, he had been an avid student of communism until he became known as "the pathologist of communism" in his native Australia.

Fred Schwarz came to America in 1953. Encouraged by Dr. Billy Graham, he organized the Christian Anti-Communism Crusade which continued for four decades as one of the most outstanding and effective groups to reveal the nature of that ideology and movement. It is no accident that he chose to include "Christian" and "crusade" in the title. It was, in large part, his vibrant Christian faith which motivated his work, and he conducted his anti-communism schools often like an evangelistic crusade.

After graduating as a medical doctor and practicing in rural communities such as Gympie and Wentworth and North Stratfield, a Sydney suburb, 1946-1955, he decided to devote himself full-time to the CACC. He first visited the United States and Europe in 1950 together with his life-long companion, his wife Lillian.

It was during a later visit to the United States that Billy Graham encouraged Fred Schwarz "to form an organization that would educate people about the communist menace and at the same time be in harmony with Christian evangelism."

Dr. Schwarz returned to the United States in 1953, leaving his medical practice and his wife in Australia to raise and educate their three children. He recalls that his first speaking engagement was at the Life Bible College and that the \$50 honorarium signaled the birth of the crusade.

It is a fascinating life, but it is difficult to categorize. It is part autobiography, part essay collection, and part documentary. With careful attention to detail, the book describes the opposition his work brought forth from the media, the intellectual left-wing elites, and even some churchmen.

What follows throughout the book is a description of the many phases of the crusade's work. He details the

opposition he met and his confrontation with much of the main-stream media. He describes his struggles with California's Attorney General Stanley Mosk, Walter Reuther, the president of the United Auto Workers' Union, Bill Leonard of CBS, and many other media moguls. His work in the 1950s and especially in the 1960s met with praise from many and calumny from some.

Time and time again Schwarz had to defend himself and his crusade from those who wished to categorize CACC as "right-wing extremists." Books such as *The Far Right*, *The Christian Fright Peddlers*, and especially *Danger on the Right*, insisted that the crusade was "Right-wing," extremist, and even that Dr. Schwarz was an anti-Semite, although his grandparents were Jewish.

Throughout these attacks, Dr. Schwarz maintained his objectivity, met the arguments of "extremism" with scholarly insights, and kept a sense of humor which was often so disconcerting to the "true believers" on the liberal left. During the 1960s, the crusade was sometimes picketed by the left-wing students at a number of universities. At that time, I was a teaching assistant working on my M.A. at the University of California at Berkeley, where the so very misnamed Free Speech movement (later renamed Filthy Speech movement) held sway.

I was also the only conservative writer for the school paper where I had some encouraging words to say about Dr. Schwarz and the CACC, to which he later expressed that "proved that island of insight still existed in the prevailing sea of insanity." At a time when many on our college campuses would say, "Rather Red than Dead," Fred Schwarz said, "Neither Red nor Dead."

The reader of this book will be inspired by the life-mission of a man whose knowledge of communism was felicitously wedded to intelligent articulation and imbued with a Christian conscience. From President Reagan to Billy Graham, many have paid tribute to this remarkable man, whom I am proud to have been able to call a friend for more than three decades.

Industrial conflicts are social forces which the Communists seek to harness. How they do this is illustrated by this article which was published in the May 3 edition of the US Communist newspaper, *People's Weekly World*.

Bullseye: Shop paper hits target in Connecticut

Communists have always placed a high priority on developing shop papers specifically aimed at workers in a given plant presenting the view of the Party on various questions. One of the most successful is the *BullsEye*, a bimonthly paper distributed at the gates of the US Repeating Arms Co. (Winchester) in New Haven, Connecticut.

A recent issue of *BullsEye* discussed the threatened closing of the plant and its impact not only on the workers involved but on the community as a whole.

In an article headlined, "Save the plant! Save our jobs!" the authors warn that sale of any plant is "a threat to the jobs, union rights, pension rights of the workers . . . and is an emergency that should be faced and dealt with better sooner than later."

In its call for united action in defense of the plant, *BullsEye* said, "Whatever the form of the attack on jobs and union rights, united union action can help turn things around. Inaction and passivity can only weaken the worker's position. Has the time come now for emergency action?" the paper asked.

The article concluded by saying: "Victory Lodge 609, IAM, does not, and will not, stand alone. Success in this struggle must involve unity with labor and people's struggles underway in New Haven and all over the country for living wage jobs with justice."

Although it is edited by the Communist Party club in New Haven, workers in the plant who are not Communists have begun submitting ideas and clippings for future issues and taking a few extra copies inside the plant.

Workers also showed their support for *BullsEye* at a fundraiser on the occasion of the 80th birthday of veteran Communist, George Fishman, a plant gate distributor of *BullsEye* and the *People's Weekly World*.

Several workers spoke of their appreciation of the Communist Party and the value of belonging to an organization under working class leadership. In his response, Fishman urged workers who want to wage a successful struggle to save the plant and for a better life to become members of the CPUSA.

THE CONTINUING NUCLEAR DANGER

The consequences of an accident may be just as devastating and deadly as a carefully-planned and efficiently-executed terrorist attack.

The possibility of a deliberate, major nuclear attack on the USA has diminished due to the collapse of the Soviet Union, but the danger of an accidental nuclear explosion has increased exponentially.

An article in the May 19 edition of *TIME* magazine, authored by Bruce W Nelan, discusses this danger.

Nelan points out that the world may still be near the brink of nuclear war because the people and the machines that control Russia's nuclear arsenal are being neglected, and the soldiers in the strategic Nuclear Forces are unpaid, unfed and unhappy. Consequently, the computer networks that control the nuclear forces are not being maintained properly, and the safeguards that prevent accidental or unauthorized launches are fraying.

Three possible scenarios concern the CIA:

1. A military coup or political crisis in Russia could lead to a breakdown in command authority, leaving new and unpredictable leaders with the power to use nuclear weapons.
2. During a panic caused by a faulty diagnosis of US actions, the Russians might wrongly believe they were under attack and fire their rockets.
3. Separatist movements in Russia might secure and use nuclear arms.

The Solution

The article presents the danger, but proposes no course of action to remove it. Those who believe in prayer should pray with the faith that while man proposes, God disposes.

The message of current events to Christian is clear. We must follow the example of Jesus who said, "I must work the works of Him that sent me while it is day; the night comes when no man can work." (John 9:4)

When the final days of life's trial are over, let the verdict be "Well done, good and faithful servant," not "You fool, this day your soul shall be required of you, and who will these things belong to then?"
